Board of Director Nominations

Criteria

- A. To be eligible for a board of directors' office, a candidate must be a member of Virginia AHPERD.
- B. No member shall hold two elected offices in the Association concurrently.
- C. Individuals may be nominated for a board position as a section chair or past chair.
- D. Individuals may be nominated for president-elect only if they have served as a division vice-president.
- E. If an individual is holding another office, the person must resign from the section or other board position.

Rules for Nomination

- A. For a nominee to be eligible, nominations must be submitted using the following procedures:
- B. Nominations must be submitted by May 15, 2025
- C. Nominations must be made on the nominations form provided by the Nominations Committee (see form 7.71, included on website).
- D. All sections of the form must be complete. The form includes spaces for:
 - 1. The name of the Virginia AHPERD member making the nomination
 - 2. A brief statement indicating the nominee's qualification and service to Virginia AHPERD and the profession
 - 3. A statement of why the individual is recommended for the board office
 - 4. An address and telephone number for the nominee
 - 5. If a verbal nomination is made prior to the deadline, a complete Nomination Form must be received by the Nomination Committee Chair within seven days of the deadline.
