## Convention Manger's Report 2013

It's time to start thinking about Convention 2013!!! President, Rodney Gaines, is very excited about this year's convention and invites all of you to attend. If you were at the Founder's Inn and Spa for a previous convention, you know what a wonderful professional experience we had and in such a great facility. We invite all of you to return for another great experience and if you have not been there, please plan to attend this year.

Past President, Charlotte Kelso, worked to get all program proposals in on time and the scheduling went very smoothly this year. Deborah Davis, once again, did a great job of typing and organizing the program. Thanks to the hard work of each of you in securing programs, our convention promises to be a good one. There are three pre conference sessions. There will be one on Thursday and two on Friday morning. There have been postings about these on the web page and in e-mails from Henry. Some require pre-registration so please check to be sure you do this if you wish to attend those. We have a large number of presentations: 40 on Friday, 70 on Saturday, and 35 on Sunday for a total of 145. In addition, there will be two general sessions, division meetings, Representative Assembly, Kaleidoscope, a dance contest, a 5K run, an Amazing Race, and an all convention dance with a deejay on Saturday night.

Even though some of the rooms are small, I believe we can accommodate all who wish to attend. There will not be any formal entertainment on Friday night but you can explore the area on your own. The hotel will provide directions to any area you wish to visit.

We will once again try to work with the hotel to offer the Saturday food and beverage breakout from 7am until 4 pm. At this time, I have not been able to work out the details but if I can make it happen, this should help with your food budget as I know funds are tight.

If you are serving on a committee, please remember that you have a committee meeting on Friday at 11 am in Mason. It is very important to be present for the committee meeting. If you are interested in serving on a committee, please let Henry Castelvecchi, our Executive Director know.

Our convention has contracts for the next five years (Founder's Inn and Spa, 2014, Richmond Kroger Center 2015 and 2016, (unless we host Southern District in 2016 which would be in Williamsburg) and The Hotel Roanoke, 2017 and 2018.

Rodney Gaines, the past vice presidents, and I will be working on the program for next year so it's never too early to start sending in proposals. Think about what you want for your division and remember to submit budget requests to cover any expenses.

Vice Presidents should remember to have an agenda and ballots prepared for their division meeting. We do seem to be doing a better job securing candidates for office and hope to have a full slate of officers for next year. Remember it is the duty of the chair elects to secure candidates for their section. They should have at least two candidates, with vitae sheets to submit to the Vice President. One of the best times to secure candidates is at convention when you can talk face to face. As section chair elects will be elected on





Saturday at the division meeting, it would be good if the VP's would have a little orientation with them and let them know about this duty. It will make the election process go a lot smoother for next year.

One more little reminder, Past VP's, the last duty of your office is to submit names to the Nomination Committee Chair for VP elects and for a Presidential Candidate. No one is in a better position than you to know who would make good candidates for office. You have worked with section officers and fellow VP's for the past three years and know who the workers are and those who would contribute to the organization.

If you as a member are interested in serving as an officer in the organization, please attend your division meeting and let others know of your interest to serve.

Donna, our exhibits manager, has once again done a great job for us working with the exhibitors. Please stop by and thank them for participating in our convention.

Remember to check the web page regularly for updates, registration, hotel information, etc. I look forward to seeing you in November.
