#### • New Funding for Title IV, Part A, ESSA Funding for FY18

President Donald Trump signed into law spending legislation that provides a significant funding increase for the Department of Education, including more money for educator development, after-school programs, and special education, among other programs.

The funding for Title IV is a huge increase over its current funding of \$400 million.

If you have the opportunity to interact with your Representative and Senators Tim Kaine and Mark Warner, thank them for the increase in funding Title IV, Part A, of ESSA and state very briefly how those funds might be used to support safe and healthy school activities. Evidence supports a direct correlation between physical and mental health and learning essential for academic success, school completion, and the development of healthy, resilient and productive citizens. Health and physical education teachers are uniquely qualified to facilitate student learning in these areas.

#### **Grants**

- Funding for Physical Education (PE) can be a struggle. The amounts available tend to be small, and programs are often tightly tailored to specific interests. Still, good options exist. There are also tools that allow physical education programs to find just the right kind of funding for their needs. Click here for a list of grants.
- The USAPA High School Grant Program assists high school PE teachers, working with a USAPA member, to acquire start-up pickleball equipment for regular physical education classes and after school programs. The maximum grant amount is up to \$350. To apply, go <a href="https://www.usapa.org">www.usapa.org</a>. Click on the "Training and Court Info" tab and scroll down to High School Grant. There you will find an article that explains the program guidelines. At the end of the article, click on Click Here to Apply. Complete and submit the application form. The Committee will review the application and notify the applicant within a reasonable period of time regarding the disposition of the application.

Middle and elementary school PE teachers may apply for a Community Grant which provides up to \$250 in reimbursable pickleball equipment.

• <u>Baseball Tomorrow Fund Offers Support for Youth Baseball and Softball Programs</u> Deadline for Letters of Inquiry: **Open** 

The Baseball Tomorrow Fund is a joint initiative between Major League Baseball and the Major League Baseball Players Association designed to promote and enhance the growth of

youth participation in baseball and softball. Grants are intended to finance a new program, expand or improve an existing program, undertake a new collaborative effort, or obtain facilities or equipment necessary for youth baseball or softball programs.

Projects must meet the following criteria: increase the number of youth participating in baseball and softball programs; improve the quality of youth baseball and softball programs; create new or innovative ways of expanding and improving baseball or softball programs; are able to match funds for programs; provide programs for children between the ages of 10 and 16; support existing programs that have demonstrated success in providing a quality youth baseball/softball experience; and address opportunities for minorities and women. Nonprofit and tax-exempt organizations involved in youth baseball programs are encouraged to submit a Letter of Inquiry. Selected applicants are then invited to submit a full application.
